Responsibilities

4. Coordinate all day to day aspects of running LEVEL 5 including operational and MarCom elements.
5. Maintain capital and operational budgets and provide relevant reports.
6. Capture usage statistics and other success indicators.
7. Complete other tasks as assigned by the Chief Innovation Officer, ISS.
